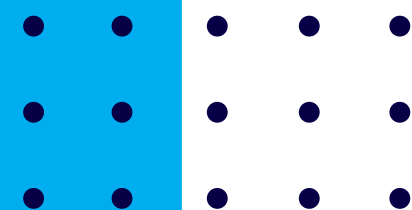




What is Little Works, Big Difference?

Daisi is inviting young people and professional artists across Devon to **contribute mini artworks** to a public exhibition and Fundraiser.

Helping **raise awareness and vital funds** to ensure local arts charity Daisi can continue its mission to give all children across Devon – particularly those who are disadvantaged or more vulnerable – access to the transformative power of the arts.



The Competition

Taking part in Little Works, Big Difference isn't just about raising vital Funds – it's also a chance for young people, schools and youth groups to shine.

The top entry will WIN a half-day workshop with a professional artist, delivered at their school or club.

Selected artwork will be displayed in a **public exhibition** alongside professional artists at The Positive Lights Project, Exeter. Date TBC. Winners will be **celebrated publically** as part of Daisi's 30th anniversary year.





Judging & Prizes

A panel of local artists and community representatives will select winners.

Three Age Categories:

- Early Years & KS1
- KS2
- KS3 & KS4

A winner from each category will receive **a set of art materials**

The Overall Winner:

Wins a **half-day creative workshop with a professional Daisi artist**, delivered in their school or youth group setting. **Worth approx £400.**

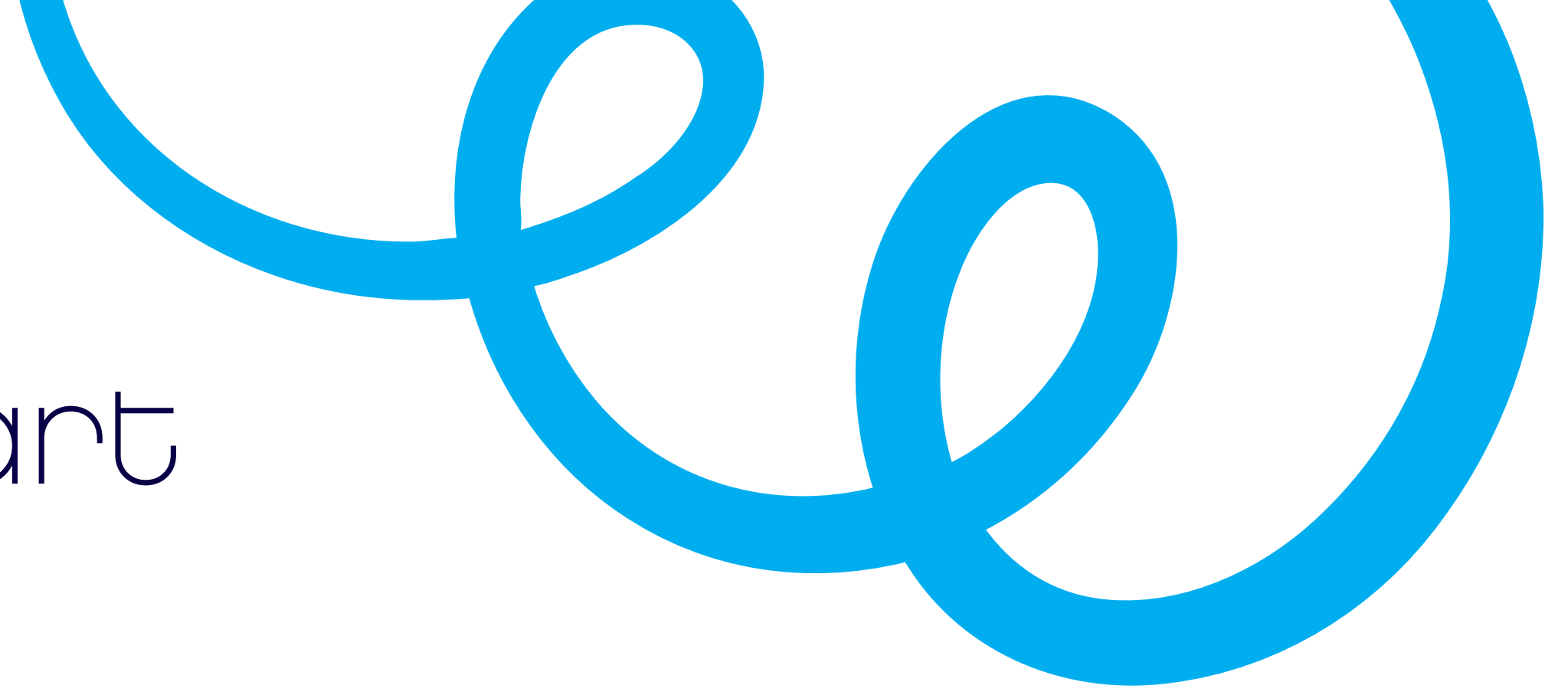


The Exhibition

Families, schools, and communities will be invited to celebrate the creativity of young people across the county and have the opportunity to purchase the art works.

How to Take Part

Get Creative

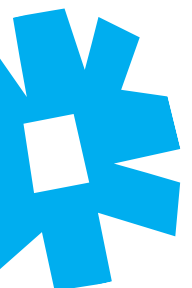
- Create an artwork on A6 or A5 card/paper (portrait or landscape).
- Use any materials: paint, collage, drawing, digital print – whatever inspires you.

Please write the young person's name and age on the back of each artwork.

Daisi has a limited supply of A6 cards available – you can request these if needed.

Collect & Send

- Gather entries from your school or group.
- Include a cover sheet with your school or group's name and contact details.

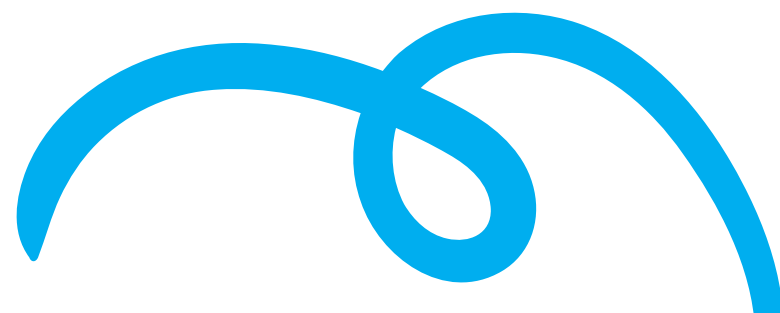

FAQS

Who can take part?

All children and young people across Devon, from Early Years through to KS4.

Is there a theme?

No, this is about exploring creativity, there are no rights or wrongs!

What size should the artwork be?

Artworks should be on A6 or A5 card/paper (portrait or landscape).

Can we use any materials?

Yes – you can paint, draw, collage, or create digitally. It's all about imagination and expression.

Do we need special materials?

Not at all. However, Daisi has a limited supply of A6/A5 cards that can be sent out on request.

What information needs to be on the artwork?

Please make sure each piece has the child's name and age written clearly on the back.

How many entries can a school or group submit?

As many as you like — one from every child, or a selected collection.

Does it cost to enter?

No. It's completely free.

Will artworks be returned?

Unfortunately not. Artworks will be part of the exhibition and may also be auctioned to raise vital funds for Daisi.

What happens to the entries?

Artwork will be displayed in a public exhibition in early 2026, alongside professional artists' work. Some will also be included in fundraising auctions.

Are there prizes?

Yes! Winners in each age group will receive a bundle of art materials, and the overall winner's school or youth group will receive a free half-day workshop with a professional artist.

How can schools or groups run this activity?

It's flexible – it can be part of an art lesson, a breakfast or after school club project, or even a fun take-home challenge.
